- Met with Robyn before the meeting to get SLRF and ARPA money correct.
- Councilmember Cochran mentioned that we needed to talk about water on July 4th. The tank went dry. The computer system that sends out alerts went down June 27th. Scada is to be out tomorrow to see what's happening. The computer is fried. He came and got a laptop from the city for a temporary fix. According to Jason Townsend if you don't get an alert that tells us something is wrong. There is miscommunication somewhere. The council requested that Lamar Rogers be given a password for Scada as well.
- The City Manager Robyn Smith asked for a motion to approve Townsend Pipeline for the quoted amount of \$10,000. A motion was made by Councilmember Greene, seconded by Councilmember Blackwell, and approved by all members present.
- Councilmember Greene said please no more handshake deals.

Tacie Bracken spoke to the council about looking at the way we allocate
payroll. This stems from Water Fund loses, with the General Fund has
cushion. The way the payroll is allocated is lopsided and allocate more
to the General Fund. Chris Lumpkin would be Water Fund 50% and
General Fund 50%, Patsy and Robyn would be 50% General Fund and
50% Water Fund, and Kelly stay at 50% Sanitation Fund and 50%
Water Fund. Once Tacie sits down with the City Manager we will come
back with a budget amendment.
