- Item 1: Call to Order

Item 3: Consideration to Approve September 26, 2016 Council Meeting Minutes

Item 4: Approval of Compression Brake Ordinance – 1st Reading

Mr. Stanley Townsend informed Mayor and Council that he was replacing the line on Pittman Lane and should be completed this week. He further informed that he felt the water loss issue from the City of Canton had been identified. He found a two (2) inch open end line without a valve or bypass. The line has now been closed off and the difference in water use should go down on the next billing.

Ms. Stewart explained that this expense had been charged to the City credit cards and later an invoice came in and was also paid. The vendor has been contacted and a refund check will be issued.
